## TIMING AND TRACKING UNIT FITMENT FOR MOTO

No Wiring needed, we will be using battery powered units that should last the duration of the event. Units will be fitted to the Tower / Handlebar wherever we find suitable space.

Fitment Station will be located at the Amber Station Gazebo or Mobile Office at Race HQ from Thursday, 20 June from 14:00 – 18:00

Fitment for late arrivals will be done from 06:30 to 09:15 on Friday, 21 June.

Removal of units will be done at the final day finish or in case of early retirement please drop off at the Amberstation Office

## RAMPAGE RALLY – DIGITAL NAVIGATION

Rally Rampage is responsible for supplying the digital roadbook and navigation options for motorbikes and cars. Here's what you need to participate:

### HARDWARE DEVICES

- **Android Tablet or Phone:** Any Android tablet or large screen phone can be used. Rugged devices are preferred for durability. Our solution does not work on Apple devices or Garmin units.
- **Mounting:** The device must be mounted in front of the rider in clear sight to be easily seen and navigated without causing distraction.
- **Mounting Options:** The tablet can be mounted on a rally tower or the handlebar of the motorbike. We generally recommend a static mount such as a tower to avoid the nav tablet's constant movement during riding.
- **Battery Life:** The Android device must be charged before any stage. A backup charging cable, device, or power supply is recommended. The device should have a 5000mAh or larger battery to run for at least 4 hours without recharging.

### RALLY BUTTONS FOR SCROLLING

- **Optional Accessory:** Traditional roadbooks use rally buttons to scroll roadbooks. For mobile devices, these are usually Bluetooth-connected devices to scroll the digital roadbook while riding.
- **Autoscroll Option:** The Rampage app allows for Autoscroll, making Bluetooth rally buttons optional.

- **Testing:** If a rider uses Bluetooth rally buttons, they must be paired and tested before the event. In case of button failure, riders can switch to Autoscroll on the screen to continue navigating.

#### **BUTTONS FOR ICO's**

- **Usage:** Traditional rally buttons allow for scrolling paper roadbooks and using CAP devices such as ICO's. The app we use already has ICO information such as cap heading and distance; however, riders may still use their ICO units as it sometimes helps with tracking all the info.
- **Optional:** Riding with ICO units is optional as this information is already displayed on the tablet.

#### **ANDROID APP - RBR Roadbook Reader**

- **App Installation:** The RBR app must be loaded on the devices. The most recent version, v103, should be installed. Earlier versions will work but have a slightly different user interface.
- **PIN System:** The app works on a PIN basis. Riders will receive a 4-letter PIN before each stage, which they enter into the app to download the roadbook or GPX track for offline use. The initial download requires internet access but after the download, internet access is not required anymore.
- **Navigation Options:** The app offers both digital interactive roadbook and GPX Trail options.
  - **Digital Roadbook:** This is not a scrolling PDF but interactive tulips, waypoints, zones, and areas.
  - **GPX Trail:** Navigate by line, with interactive waypoints and zones similar to the roadbooks.
- **Flexibility:** Riders will receive a PIN for each option and can choose which one to use during each stage.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION** Rampage primarily endorses two apps for interactive roadbooks and events: Terra Pirata and RBR. For this event, we will be using RBR due to its Autoscroll ability and the GPX Trail option, which allows navigation by line instead of roadbook.
